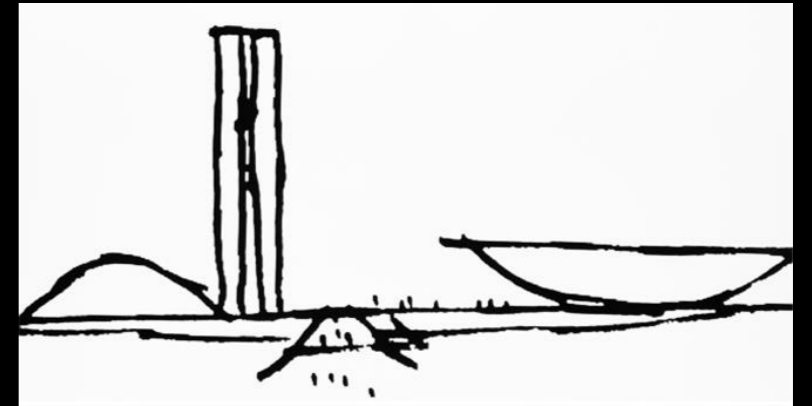

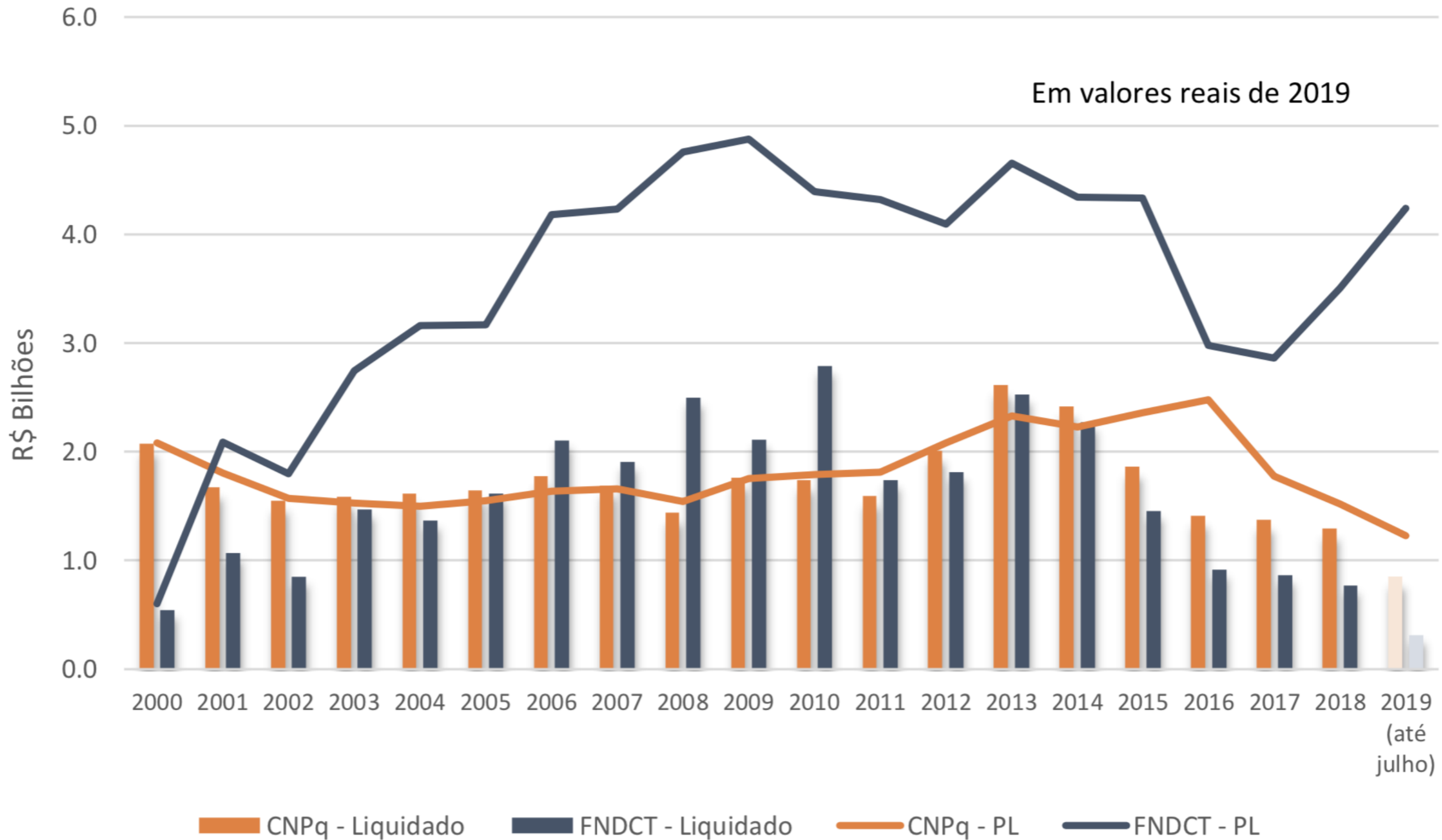

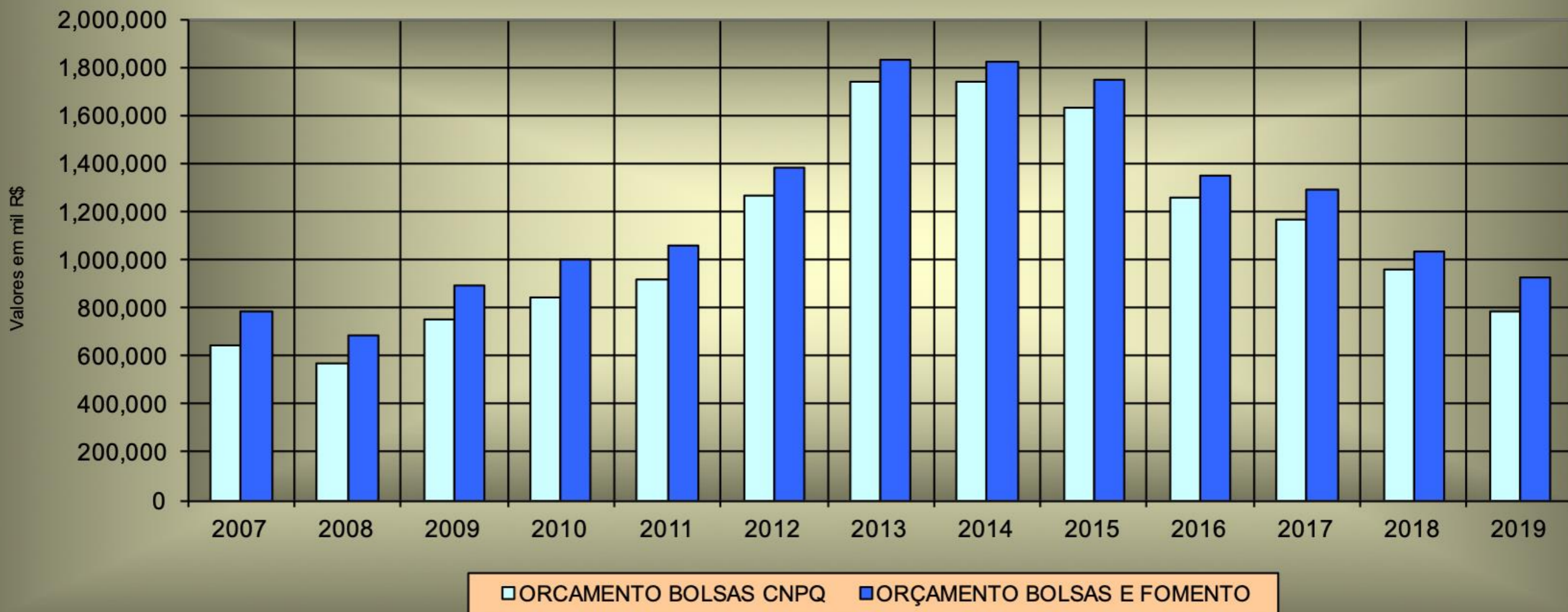

# Orçamento do FNDCT e do CNPq entre 2000 e 2019: valores orçados no projeto de lei (PL) e liquidados até julho de 2019.

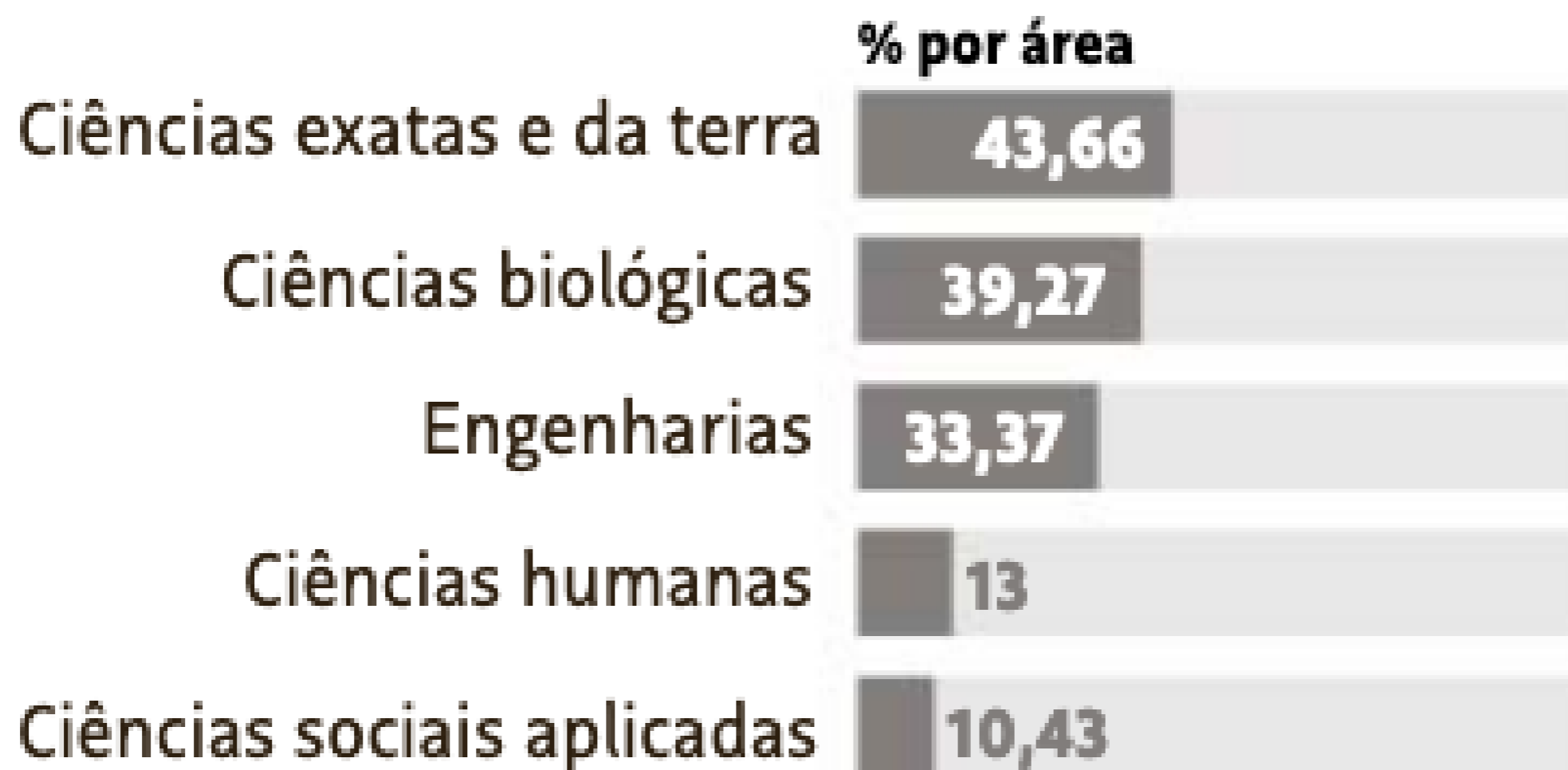


# ORÇAMENTO DO CNPQ

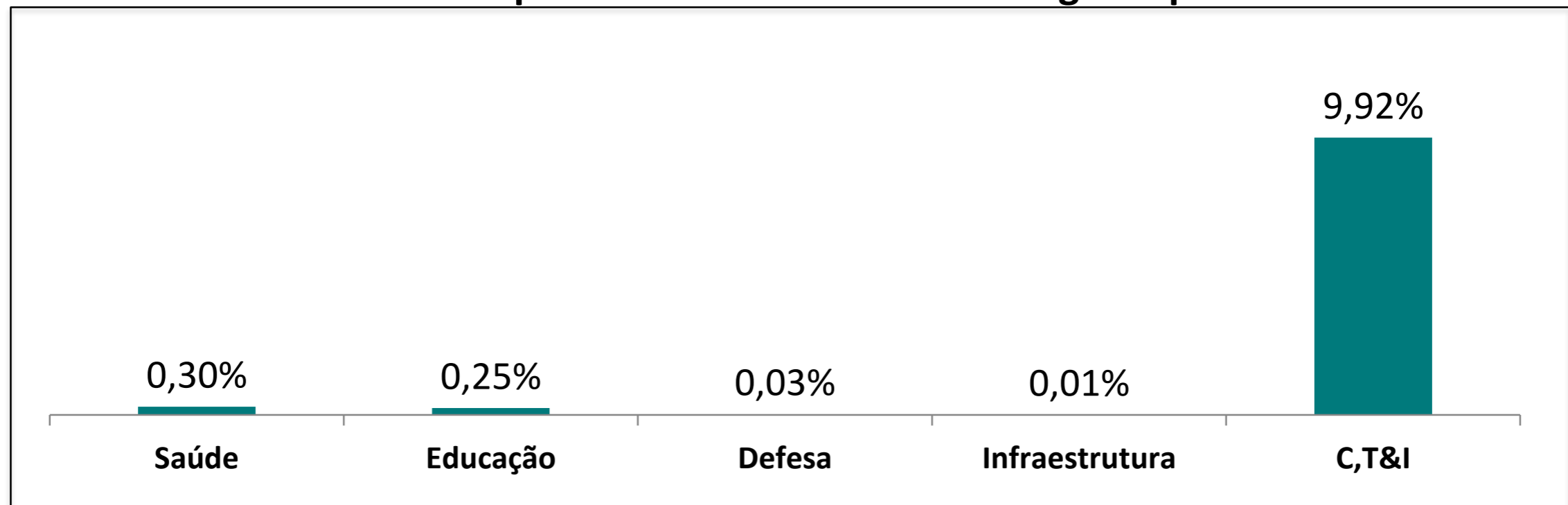

## A Bumper Year for Chinese Science



**Slowdown strategy.** With a slackening economy in sight, Wen Jiabao says China will focus on research that boosts growth.

**BEIJING**—Another year, another chance for scientists here to pop the champagne corks. In a draft budget released on 5 March at the opening session of the annual National People's Congress, China has earmarked 32.45 billion yuan (\$5.14 billion) for basic research in 2012—up 26% from last year's appropriation.

**BHUBANESWAR, INDIA**—India's Prime Minister Manmohan Singh has vowed to more than double his nation's spending on R&D over the next 5 years and build two major research facilities. The ambitious pledge, made here yesterday at the annual Indian Science Congress, is expected to be a highlight of the government's new 5-year plan now being finalized before its submission to parliament in March or April.

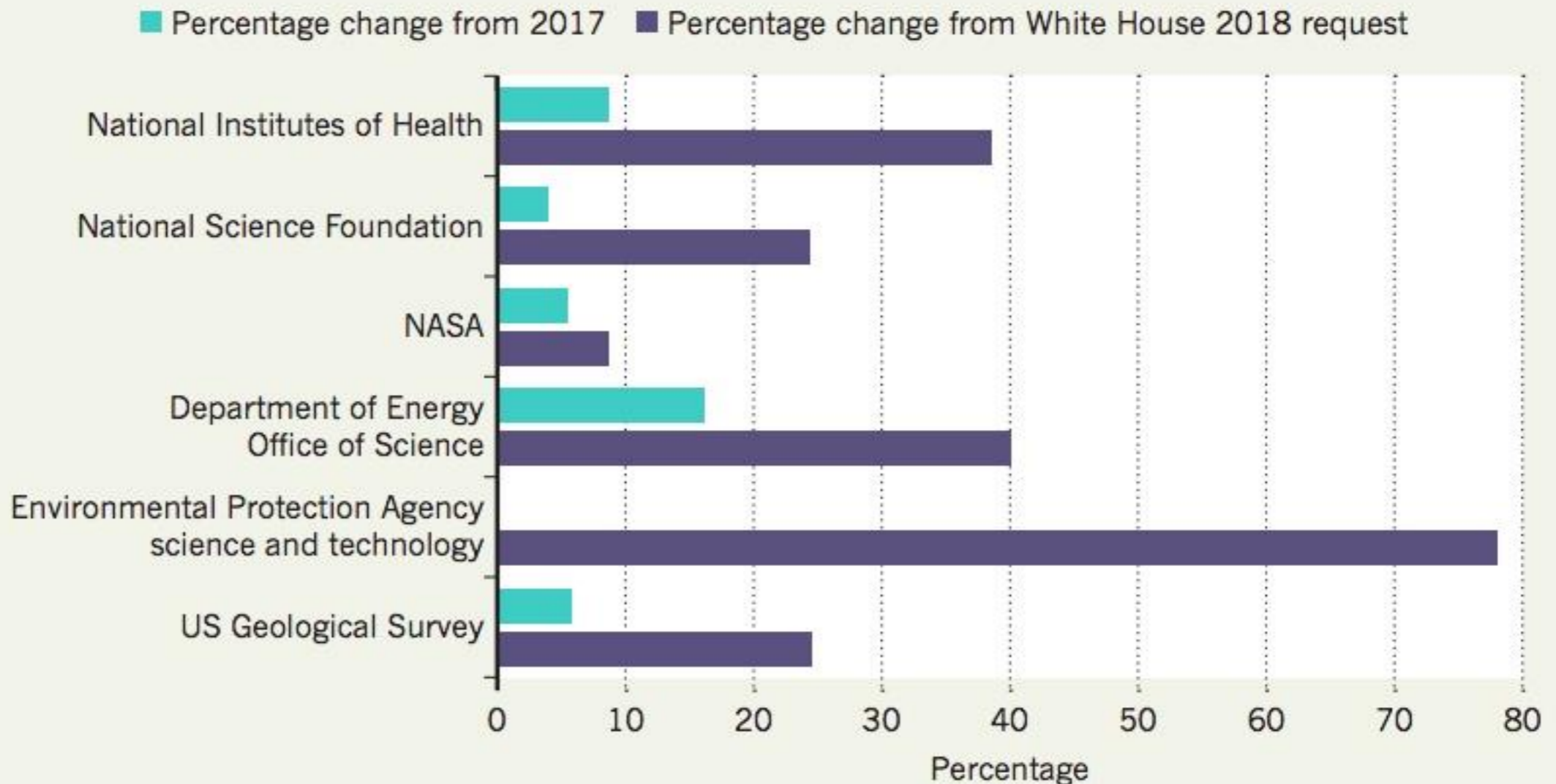
