While parents want to do the best by their children, many have no option but to work long hours in the formal or informal sectors, simply to make ends meet.




From 'maternal' to 'parental' leave

From 'infrastructure' to 'people'


These policies invest in families so they can provide both time and support to the young child, and protection for women against discrimination or retaliation from employers.


From 'individual' to 'co-responsibility'
