

WHAT IS A.I.?

Innovation and Investment Friendly Policy Approaches

- Public/Private Partnership
 - Leverage industry partners as a resource
 - Diverse stakeholders need to communicate
- Global solutions
 - Global standards and best practices
 - Multilateral approaches
- Accountability / Voluntary Co-Regulation
 - Companies demonstrate accountable practices, voluntarily submit to enforcement
- Avoiding Siloed Regulatory Approaches
 - Essential to realizing the economic benefits of IoT, Big Data, further innovations

Practical Privacy and Data Protection Policy Guidance

- Allow multiple legal grounds for processing, including legitimate interests
- Recognize appropriateness of different kinds of consent based on context
- Create contextually aware definitions of personal data with exceptions
- Sensitive data categories should be clearly defined in a closed list
- Create balanced laws sensitive to privacy risks and potential social benefits of innovative technologies
- Institute a flexible and harm preventative data breach notification regime
- Create accountability-based systems with clear delineations of liability
- Provide multiple mechanisms for cross-border data transfers, avoid data localization and overreliance on adequacy
